



The Delaware Captive Insurance Association congratulates Steve Kinion for earning the International Center for Captive Insurance Education/ICCIE's Associate in Captive Insurance (ACI) designation.

Steve is the Director of Captive Insurance and Financial Products for Delaware's Department of Insurance. The ACI is the highest professional designation in the captive insurance industry and ICCIE is the premiere provider of captive insurance education globally. Since the ACI was first awarded in 2004, only 601 captive insurance professionals have earned the ACI. Steve is now a member of an even more exclusive club as one of only five chief state captive insurance regulators in the United States who holds the ACI.

The Delaware Department of Insurance is one of only four insurance regulatory bodies in the world that is an "ICCIE Trained Organization." Awarded by ICCIE, an organization must have (1) at least 20% of the captive professionals in its organization hold the Associate in Captive Insurance (ACI) in good standing; and (2) at least 30% of the organization's captive professionals must be ACIs, Certificate in Captive Insurance (CCI) holders, or currently enrolled in the ACI or CCI program.

Delaware exceeds these standards. Currently 65% of its captive professionals hold the ACI in good standing.
